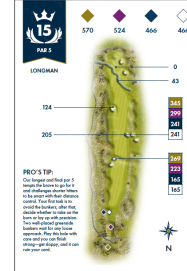
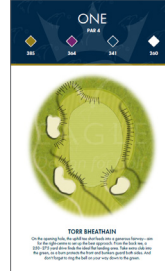


HISTORY

The Kings Golf Club was established in 2019 having emerged from the demise of the old Torvean Golf Club (Est. c1962). The development of the expanding City of Inverness forced the closure of Torvean Golf course to make way for new roads and bridges over the Caledonian Canal. A new course was designed by Stuart Rennie incorporating land previously used by the Old Torvean course thus ensuring an eternal connection.

Remnants of an Iron Age fortress can be found on a nearby hilly crag atop of Craig Phadraig, overlooking the golf course. The site of a mighty bastion of early Pictish Kings with clear views over what was to become, the Capital of the Highlands, it is believed to be the seat of King Brude.

King Brude (Bridei mac Maelchu c. 555-584), was a King of many Pictish Kingdoms and mentioned by the venerable St Bede as being "Rex Potentissimus" – the most powerful of Kings. Three sites of archaeological interest have been excavated at different locations, suggesting this may well be an area on which the Kings followers lived. .



It is believed St. Columba camped close to the River Ness west of Inverness whilst waiting for an audience with the King and perhaps on the very land the course now occupies

The course measures 6612 yards from the back tees and meanders up the hill and back down. The fairways are generous, but be careful, if you miss the green it could be a tough up and down! All the greens and tees are USGA specification so there is no excuse when that 3 foot putt misses just right!

Views from the 12th hole are particularly impressive, overlooking Inverness City, down the Moray Firth and over the hills to the South.

The finishing hole is a 366 yard, par 4 with the green nicely tucked on the other side of a pond. A great hole to finish a memorable round of golf.

After the round you can relax in the comfort of the new clubhouse and enjoy a drink and some food while watching others tackle the 1st and 18th.



ATMOSPHERE

The Kings Golf Club pride ourselves on being a welcoming and friendly club. Opened in 2019, the Kings Golf Club Inverness, is a full equipped golf facility with an 18 Hole Championship Golf Course, Practice Range and chipping area, Pro Shop and Bar and Restaurant.

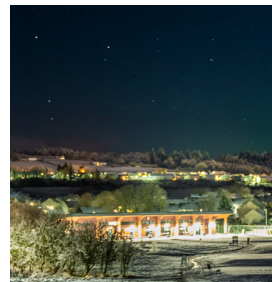
